AFRICA-EU B2B MATCHMAKING EVENT AT THE ALER CONFERENCE: RENEWABLES IN THE ELECTRIFICATION OF MOZAMBIQUE, 25-26 OCTOBER 2017



The Lusophone Renewable Energy Association (ALER), with the support of the Africa-EU Renewable Energy Cooperation Programme (RECP), invited the actors of the renewable energy industry to a conference on **Renewables in the electrification of Mozambique** on 25th and 26th October in Maputo, Mozambique.

The conference brought together more than 300 international stakeholders to discuss the contribution of renewable energies for the electrification of Mozambique, in line with the objective of reaching universal access by 2030. During two days, the participants had the opportunity to meet and exchange ideas with high-level representatives of the principal Mozambican institutions.

In total, **117 participants** originating from a dozen of different countries, **65%** of them from **African countries**, attended the B2B Matchmaking event. During the event, more than 126 meetings were held during eight time slots. RECP representatives met with many participants who were interested in RECP services.




Figure 1: Response to "Did the event meet your expectations?"

The two evaluations conducted among the participants immediately after and six weeks after the event, showed that the B2B Matchmaking event was a success. The event exceeded the expectations of a majority of participants. In the retrospective online evaluation, participants also rated the individual results of the meetings they had. A large share of the meetings, i.e. **58%** of the encounters that took place led to cooperation between both participants.

All participants were also given the opportunity to meet other conference visitors as well as panellists and speakers during the B2B Matchmaking. In preparation of the three hours of B2B Matchmaking sessions, participants were able to schedule meetings with potential cooperation partners beforehand on an online platform.




Figure 3: What is the outcome of the meetings you had during the matchmaking event?

The B2B Matchmaking event during the conference proved to be a useful instrument for public and private stakeholders to meet and exchanges ideas on how to fulfil the universal access in Mozambique by 2030. Many contacts were tied and tangible outcomes can be expected. The B2B Matchmaking sessions therefore have been a substantial contribution to the strengthening of the sector of renewables in Mozambique.
